D. Public Communication

Daniel Dombrowski wished all a safe and healthy Thanksgiving.

Timothy Houlihan announced the Lakers Unified Hockey Game vs the Alumni Unified Team on Wednesday, November 26 at 7:30 PM.

Philip Thomas commented on the success of the Marching Band's Annual Craft Show and thanked Director of Operations and Athletics Sean Zaborowski for his help during the event.

Michael Wenner announced that auditions for the Community Musical - *Seussical the Musical* will be held December 2 and 3 at Schaublin Auditorium.

Michael McCain apologized to the Board for his actions during the October 21, 2008, Board Meeting when he communicated with a parent during the regular meeting.

Daniel Dombrowski asked that the scheduling of events throughout the District be reviewed and not conflict with other building uses.

Philip Thomas announced that this year's Cabaret will be held December 10 at Athena Hall. He also requested that Board recognitions be placed at the beginning of future Board Meeting agendas.

Karl Paulson confirmed that Board recognitions will be placed at the front end of the Board Meeting Agenda. He also stated that the District will continue to refine the scheduling of District events with balancing of potential revenue sources when there may be conflicts.

Mr. Paulson announced that several staff members are currently working with Congressman Sander Levin's office and the Zero Tolerance Committee. He also shared that the Optimist Club of St. Clair Shores ran their first joint effort with the SCS Police Department and the Rapid Search Network at Princeton Elementary on November 5. Throughout the year, students in St. Clair Shores will have the opportunity to be added to the Rapid Search Network Database for missing children.

Mr. Paulson informed the Board that administration is reviewing and collecting data from the Steering Committees. He will continue to share that information with the Board as it becomes available.

F. Student Representative Report

Student Representative Paige Fouty reported that Lakeview High School won the Food Fight Challenge between the three Shores' school districts. Lakeview High School students and staff collected over 300 pounds of food and \$1,000 which placed them in the Top 10 in Wayne, Oakland, and Macomb County. The first Blood

Drive is scheduled for December 1 from 8 AM – 2 PM and Caberet is scheduled at Athena Hall on December 10. Paige announced that she will be absent from the December 16 Board Meeting due to personal reasons.




