E. Board of Education and Administration Comment

Carol Herbon thanked Lakeview High School Principal Bob duBois for the recent tour of the building; commenting on how great the construction looked. She also announced that she attended State Representative Sarah Robert's Open House on Saturday, October 17th.

Anne McDaid informed the Board that the Ardmore PTO is selling Brick Pavers for \$30. The pavers, which are being sold until February 2010, are in recognition of former Ardmore Principal Kathy Simonelli.

Philip Thomas also thanked Mr. duBois for the recent tour of the construction work at the high school. He was impressed at how the cafeteria space looks and how it will function.

Michael McCain commented that he also attended Representative Robert's Open House.

Timothy Houlihan stated how gorgeous the high school building is looking especially with all the new glass in the cafeteria.

Michael Wenner reminded everyone that the General Election is November 3, 2009. He encouraged everyone to go out and vote. He reported on last week's Girls' Volleyball Cancer Awareness Fundraiser which raised over \$3,100 for the Karmonas Cancer Institute.

Superintendent Karl Paulson updated the Board on the New Teacher Orientation that took place October 14th. He was impressed with the new staff from 2008/09 and 2009/10.

Mr. Paulson stated that the punch lists are progressing well for the construction throughout the District and that the high school Gym and Cafeteria should be available by February 2010.

Mr. Paulson reported that he has been visiting the PTO's throughout the District; sharing details about the successful start of the school year. Things are very positive throughout the District. He acknowledged and thanked the teachers and administrators for working to have all of our schools make AYP.

He announced the District will be hosting the Macomb County Health Department H1N1 Flu Shot Clinic on November 10th.

Mr. Paulson informed the Board that he will be meeting with State Representative Roberts once a month starting in November to share school district information and education issues impacting Lakeview.

Executive Director of Curriculum and Technology Tracy VanPeeren stated that the MEAP testing is in full swing for Grades 3 through 9. MEAP testing is being done in a shorter window but the testing time is longer per day.

Ms. VanPeeren reported that the 5th Grade Music program is in full swing and that all students have received their instruments.

Ms. VanPeeren announced that Lakeview Public Schools along with South Lake, Lake Shore, and the city are working with

Michigan Roundtable to address the city's changing dynamics and diversity. Two focus groups – students and staff have met and a parent group is scheduled to meet on November 10th at 6:30 PM in the Community Meeting Room.

Mr. Paulson stated that the Lake St. Clair Symphony Orchestra is back performing at Lakeview's Schaublin Auditorium. They will be offering our 5th Grade music students free concert admission for performances scheduled at Lakeview.

Student Representative Kristen Kiluk reported that the students are currently involved in a competition with South Lake in the Gleaners Food Fight which is being held October 12th – 23rd. The students are half way to their goal and are hoping to win this year's competition. The next blood drive is scheduled on November 30th, 8 AM – 2 PM. Walk-ins are welcome. October 27th and 28th are Parent Teacher Conferences. Kristen reported on the field trip that Team Green recently took to Marygrove College. Also, Student Congress is working on scheduling dates for the next Texas Hold 'em fundraiser.


