I. BOARD OF EDUCATION

A. Pledge of Allegiance

The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Board President Daniel Dombrowski welcomed all to the Budget Hearing and Workshop Meeting.

B. 2010 – 2011 Budget Hearing

Ms. Tasha McIntyre, Director of Business Services, reviewed the reason for the Budget Hearing, presented information on the proposed 2010/2011 budget and answered Board questions. Ms. McIntyre stated that the 2010/2011 Budget adoption will be presented during the June 15, 2010 Regular Board Meeting.

Ms. McIntyre also stated that the District has met the legal requirements by publishing notice of the budget and truth in taxation hearing in the newspaper.

C. Headlee Millage Election

Superintendent Karl Paulson presented two options for the Board to review regarding the Operating Millage Renewal Proposal. An election could be held in August 2010, November 2010 or February 2011 for a period of five years or ten years. Discussion followed. The Board directed Mr. Paulson to go forward with an August 2010 election for a period of ten years.

The Operating Millage Renewal Proposal Resolution will be presented for Board approval at the May 18, 2010 Regular Board Meeting.

C. Land Use Discussion

Mr. Paulson shared with the Board that the District had been

Discussion followed. The Board does not want to sell any District property.


Adjournment Donald Wheaton moved, supported by Michael McCain, to adjourn the Budget Hearing and Workshop meeting at 8:04 PM.


