BOARD OF EDUCATION

A. Pledge of Allegiance

The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

B. Instructional Presentations

1. Response to Intervention Summary

Director of Student Services Chris Brown, Jefferson Middle School Principal Sherry Michalowicz, and teacher Jen Donnelly presented a snapshot summary of the Response to Intervention (RtI) Program that began at Lakeview during the 2009/10 school year.

Some of the accomplishments for this year include formation of building teams and professional development, K-2 screeners and data analysis, ongoing research and training of core staff, revamped after-school tutoring program, elementary and special education teachers collaborating, SLP – training and more push-in services, selection of a universal screener – NWEA to be used to assess students three times a year, creation of a Kindergarten Snapshot, and development of data to drive instruction. Plans for next year were also provided.

2. E2020 at Jefferson Middle School and Lakeview High School

Jefferson Middle School Principal David Lavender and teacher Jennifer Zaborowski presented the E2020 Program currently in use at JMS. E2020 is an on-line virtual learning environment that is web based. Students work at their own pace. Currently JMS offers language arts and math courses but will add science and social studies during the summer of 2010.

Lakeview High School Assistant Principal Scott Kapla provided a summary of how E2020 is used at the high school for credit recovery courses and accelerated classes. He attempted to present a demonstration of the program from a teacher's access and students use but the District's web server was down at the MISD so could

not share the specific information with the Board at this time.

C. Lakeview Public Schools On-Line Learning Options, Chartering a "Virtual Academy"

Mr. Paulson shared with the Board the idea of the Board creating a web based Virtual Academy. Administration had been in contact with legal counsel for direction and feasibility and wanted to know if the Board would be interested in requesting the Michigan Department of Education for a waiver of the 2-hour limit of students being on E2020. Discussion followed.

The Board directed Mr. Paulson to provide more information on the school board sponsoring virtual academies as a charter and to seek preliminary MDE approval. An outline of highlights will be prepared for the Board's review.

D. Superintendent Evaluation Discussion

The Board discussed the Superintendent's Evaluation process. Mr. Dombrowski had been in contact with Mr. Paulson and he stated a willingness to postpone his evaluation until the June Board Meeting.

Board members are to use the evaluation instrument that will be email to them and return it to Mr. Dombrowski by May 30th. The Superintendent's Evaluation will be presented at the June 15, 2010 Board Meeting. An updated goals document will also be provided in the next couple weeks.


