**BOARD OF EDUCATION**

The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

**E. Board of Education and Administration Comments**

Carol Herbon commented on the success of this year's Cabaret and wished all a Merry Christmas and Happy New Year. She also thanked everyone for the Christmas goodies at her place.

Superintendent Karl Paulson reflected on the District's accomplishments this past year.

**F. Student Representative Report**

Student Representative Hannah Lampron was not in attendance at the time of the Student Report. In her absence, high school principal Brent Case reported that the National Honor Society raised \$1,000 for the Holiday Raffle. Donations went to McRest. Also, 184 toys, hats, scarves and mittens were donated to McRest.

Timothy Houlihan stated that he had attended the Cheer Competition where Lakeview High School came in first place out of 17 teams. He announced that the Lakers have a game Wednesday night and that there will be a Holiday Tournament on Monday and Tuesday. The team currently is 3 wins / 3 losses.

Donald Wheaton announced that auditions for the Community Musical - Cinderella had been moved to January 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> due to the inclement weather and school closing last week. He informed the Board that last year's musical raised over \$10,000 that was used for scholarships by students to attend enrichment programs.

Philip Thomas recognized the Greenwood 5<sup>th</sup> Graders Solar Systems that are currently on display in the Community Meeting Room and hallway.

Mr. Dombrowski also commented on the new showcases to display student work in the hallway.

Superintendent Paulson commented on the District receiving the NCA Recognition Banner for receiving accreditation in 2009. The banner will remain on display in the Community Meeting Room.

Ms. Herbon stated that she attended the Lakeview vs. Lake Shore Alumni Hockey Game which was a fundraiser for Lakeview student Billy Lockett. Lakeview had a great showing of support at this event.

**G. Michigan Round Table – Community Youth Diversity Council Presentation**

Student representatives from Lakeview, Lake Shore and South Lake presented a PowerPoint on the goals of the organization and information on the upcoming Youth Diversity Summit scheduled for January 13, 2011 at the Lakeshore YMCA.

Mr. Dombrowski congratulated and thanked the students on undertaking this initiative in the city of St. Clair Shores.

Michael McCain recognized these students as leaders in the

community.

Student Representative Hannah Lampron arrived late and reported that the November 29<sup>th</sup> Blood Drive collected 63 units of blood which equates to saving 189 lives. She reported that the canned food drive, that ran November 29<sup>th</sup> through December 10<sup>th</sup>, collected 1,378 cans of non-perishable food that will be donated to the St. Clair Shores Goodfellows. The Coming Home Game and Dance are scheduled for January 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> respectively. Student Government is working on a School Dance Code of Conduct.

She reported that Student Government donated \$1,500 to the SCS Cops for Kids and the art department has collected pieces of student art that will be on display for the Scholar Art Show. The District is conducting a Martin Luther King Essay and Art Contest. The high school winner in the MLK Contest is Danielle Raymond.

#### **H. Summer 2011 Bond Projects Discussion**

Darren McKenna and David Gassen from Partners In Architecture and Steve Rewers, Barton Malow, presented an overview of potential bond related projects – Bid Package 9 for Jefferson Middle School, Lakeview High School Athletic Field and auditorium dressing rooms/restrooms, and building signage throughout the District.

Superintendent Paulson informed the Board that after the bidding process is complete, work could begin by April 4, 2011.

There was extensive discussion on intelligent lighting for the auditorium. Consensus of the Board was to wait for Bid Pack #9 to be completed before continuing further discussion on intelligent lighting.

- Health benefits concessions to include an increased deductible for 2012/2013 to \$200/\$400 and for 2013/2014 to \$300/\$600.
- School calendar 2011/12 through 2014/15, to include 179 student days / 183 teacher days.
- Other concessions on high school staff and prep time
- A rigorous merit based annual teacher evaluation model.




