The meeting began with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Board President Daniel Dombrowski welcomed all to the meeting. Mr. Dombrowski announced that Mr. Wenner was absent due to a personal conflict and that Mr. Wheaton would serve as temporary secretary in Mr. Wenner's absence. He also advised the Board that there was a revised personnel write-up at their places.

E. Board of Education and Administration Comments

Philip Thomas congratulated the students in Concert Band who recently received a Division I rating at District's.

Donald Wheaton reminded everyone that the community musical "Cinderella" begins this weekend. All proceeds go towards enrichment scholarships for our students.

Timothy Houlihan congratulated the Unified Lakers Hockey Team for their 11-10-3 season. During playoffs they were Regional Champs for the first time since 2006.

Superintendent Karl Paulson commented on high school scheduling and the progress of the contract with Wayne State University offering college courses to our students on our high school campus. He will provide further information as it becomes available. He also announced that the District recently received an improved credit rating from "A" to "A+" from Standard & Poors.

He also commented on the Strategic Planning meeting that took place several weeks ago. The District is currently two (2) years into the adopted Strategic Plan. He will present the results of the meetings to the Board at a later date.

Paulson also told the Board that the District received positive feedback from the Michigan Department of Education during the recent Grant Audit for Title I, At Risk, and Special Education Funds. The state official was complimentary to our staff including Assistant Superintendent Tracy VanPeeren, Director of Student Services Christine Brown, Director of Business Services Tasha McIntyre, Harmon Principal Amy Gaglio and Interim Principal Justin Cabe and the Harmon teachers.

Lastly, he remarked about the financial state of Michigan being in disarray and that it is imperative for our parents and community to make their opinions and voices heard at the government level. Our state representative's contact information is available on the District website.

Assistant Superintendent Tracy VanPeeren also commented on the Grant Audit stating that the District was well prepared and that staff worked hard to be in compliance. She stated that the Elementary Report Card Committee has been working on the electronic report card which will have a kick-off next school year.

She also announced that the enrollment process will be available for online registration this spring. It is "user friendly" and the District will provide a computer on site and assist families that do

not have access at home. She also reported that students were currently going through the Kindergarten "Snapshot" and she asked if anyone knows of a kindergartener that will be enrolling for the next school year they should contact the Curriculum Office so they can be placed.

Daniel Dombrowski commented on the 15% cap for fund balances that is being proposed by Senator Jack Brandenburg.

Philip Thomas stated he was excited about Wayne State University offering classes on our campus giving our students graduating from Lakeview High School university credits. He also commented positively on the parent portal.

Michael McCain commented that the District should contact local press to get the word out about the Kindergarten "Snapshots" being done.

F. Student Representative Report

Student Representative Hannah Lampron stated that the students are still waiting for the final tally on the collection competition between Lakeview High School and Grosse Pointe North. She announced that students will be selling Shamrocks in March for MDA, the junior class is selling back packs, and prom tickets go on sale next Monday. During April, the students will run the Pennies for Pasta fundraiser for three weeks and that on May 28th there will be a Relay for Life fundraiser dinner. She also announced that five of the pieces of art that were on display at the Clinton Library last month will now progress to Western Michigan University. She also announced that the Anton Art Exhibit Opening was Sunday and that Lakeview has several pieces on display.

Student Long-term Suspension / Expulsion Hearing #2010/11RF

Donald Wheaton moved, supported by Timothy Houlihan, to approve a long-term suspension through the end of the 2010/11 school year for Student #2010/11RF for delivery or receipt of, and use of controlled substances on school property. Student #2010/11RF can be reinstated only for the purpose of earning enough credits to graduate with a Lakeview High School diploma upon meeting the voluntary terms and conditions listed below.

- The student provides outside counseling recommendations and provides certification of attendance to high school administration through a "Release of Information" (*Consent of Release and/or Exchange of Confidential Student Information*) provided back to the high school principal's office.
- Clean results from random weekly drug and alcohol testing at the parents' expense until the end of the school year.
- The student is restricted from participation or attendance at any extra curricular activities on or off campus, and may not attend or participate in prom and senior activities related to graduation including but not limited to senior follies, awards nights, graduation ceremony, and/or the all-night party.

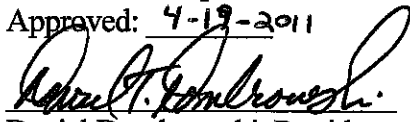
