The Regular Meeting of the Board of Education, Lakeview Public Schools, St. Clair Shores, Michigan, convened at 7:30 PM at the Ian Smith, Sr., Administrative Center, 20300 Statler, Daniel Dombrowski, President, presiding.

Board President Daniel Dombrowski welcomed all to the meeting and advised the Board that Mr. Thomas would be arriving late.

E. Student Representative Report

Timothy Houlihan reported that the first season game for the Lakers Unified Hockey Team will be November 9th against Troy. This year's team consists of 8 Lake Shore, 14 Lakeview

and 2 South Lake players.

Carol Herbon commented on how she appreciated the students having the day after Halloween off for professional development.

Assistant Superintendent Tracy VanPeeren stated that the teachers' contract for the next four years also has professional development scheduled for November 1st unless Halloween falls on a Saturday.

Donald Wheaton announced that the Girls' Swim Team only had two (2) losses this year and that they are in the Division Meet this week.

Philip Thomas arrived at 7:36 PM.

Mr. Houlihan also reported that the Boys' Cross Country Team ended their season 12 – 0.

Daniel Dombrowski announced that bowling tryouts were coming up and that there is a Bowling Fund Raiser on Friday, November 18th at Harbor Lanes.

Mr. Thomas apologized for arriving late. He announced that the Marching Band was going to the State Finals at Ford Field this Saturday. Lakeview's Flight is scheduled sometime between 1 PM – 3 PM. Tickets are available through Jody Thompson.

Superintendent Karl Paulson congratulated all the teams and the Marching Band for a successful season. He also reminded everyone to vote on November 8th. He reported on the positive responses from the high school's parent survey taken during Parent Teacher Conferences and the successful all-day professional development activities held District-wide which were conducted by our administrators and some teachers.

Michael McCain also reminded everyone to vote and made a personal comment in support of the November 8th Special Education Enhancement Millage issue.

Ms. Herbon commented about the Macomb Intermediate School District holding MASB leadership classes at their facilities. The last time the MASB held classes at the MISD, the MISD reimbursed all district in attendance the tuition costs for the MASB classes offered at that time. She advised that any board members interested in taking the classes should let Mr. Paulson know for follow-up.


