E. Board of Education and Administration Comments
Donald Wheaton reported that the girls’ swim team won this evening’s meet 116 – 53 and have another meet scheduled for Thursday evening.

Carol Herbon shared the positive comments she heard on the first day of school.

“Philip Thomas commented on the attendance at last Thursday’s home football game and the number of students getting involved in activities.

Michael Wenner welcomed everyone back including all new students and their families to the 2011/12 school year. He shared his disappointment in Jefferson Middle Schools’ scheduling of accelerated classes which conflict with band and orchestra classes.

Superintendent Karl Paulson reported that central office administrators were in strategic places throughout the District in the morning watching the traffic flow for dropping off students. He reported that Jefferson Middle School and Lakeview High School shared a guest speaker on the first day and that Greenwood hosted their annual "Tissues & Tea" for parents. He announced that new technology had been installed in 20 classrooms this summer.

Assistant Superintendent Tracy VanPeeren advised the Board that she would provide a more formal enrollment count by the end of the week but her office reports that there were over 1,000 interested students this summer with over 700 of them enrolling. By Friday, the schools will know which students are reporting for the new school year.

Director of Operations & Athletics Sean Zaborowski reported that the new tennis courts at Jefferson were officially opened at 3 PM today, September 6, 2011. The boys' tennis team hosted their first match on the courts.

Mr. Dombrowski asked about the status of the baseball field at Princeton. Mr. Zaborowski reported that the construction fencing is now down and that the city has approved the request for additional fencing and netting. This request has been forwarded to the state for final approval.


