SAFETY CONCERNS!

As the weather warms, safety issues are increasing. Please take note of the following:

Please put your child / ren in closed-toed shoes at school. Children are starting to wear cros, and soon will consider wearing sandals and flip flops. Their toes are at risk for being stepped on, and they can get abrasions from the wood chips on the playground. Climbing and running in shoes other than tennis shoes is difficult and dangerous. The children can wear their open-toed shoes at home, but please consider their safety and comfort while at school by providing a sturdy running shoe.

The after school traffic is still a major concern at our school. Students may NOT walk across the street at places other than the official cross-walks to get to their cars. Some parents are motioning their children to cross Greater Mack in the middle of the street, rather than having the children cross at the cross-walks. This puts children at risk. Your cooperation is appreciated.

Another serious concern is when pedestrians cut across the parking lot, rather than using the sidewalks. The heavy mix of cars and kids makes the unexpected even more dangerous. The cars in the parking lot are not expecting pedestrians to stroll in their path. Cutting kitty-corner across the lot does not save enough time to warrant a serious accident. Please proceed to and from the school on the sidewalks.

Thank you for your cooperation. Please know we are simply supporting our aim to keep all children safe before, during and after school.
