Assessment

- Assessment drives our instruction.
- **Formal assessments** include tests, short answer questions; multiple choice questions; true and false questions
- **Informal assessments** include group or individual projects, journal writing, oral discussions, and keeping notes or checklists on individual children.



Kindergarten Screener

- Lakeview will be administering a **free** kindergarten screener to all incoming students.
- Parents/Guardians will be contacted to schedule a time in early May for their child to be assessed.
- The assessment will provide us with information on the child to help us design instruction that is targeted to their child's needs.
- The results will also inform parents what skills need to be worked on over the summer.

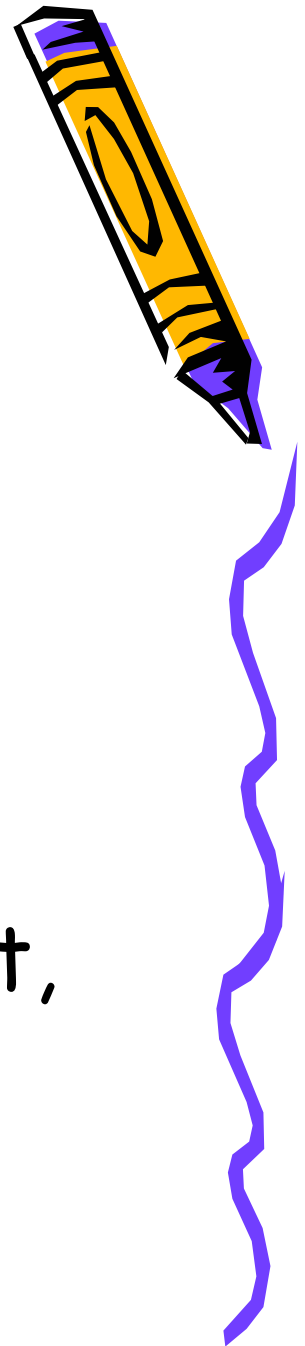


- Lakeview Currently Has 5 Special Classes, which are:

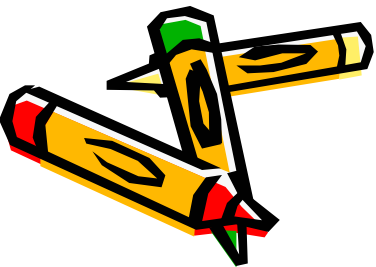
- Physical Education (gym)	45 minutes

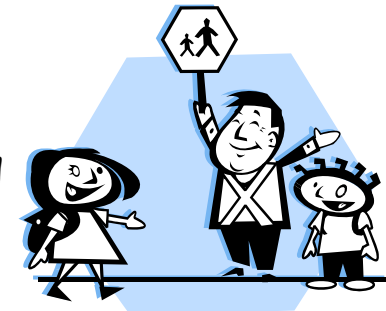

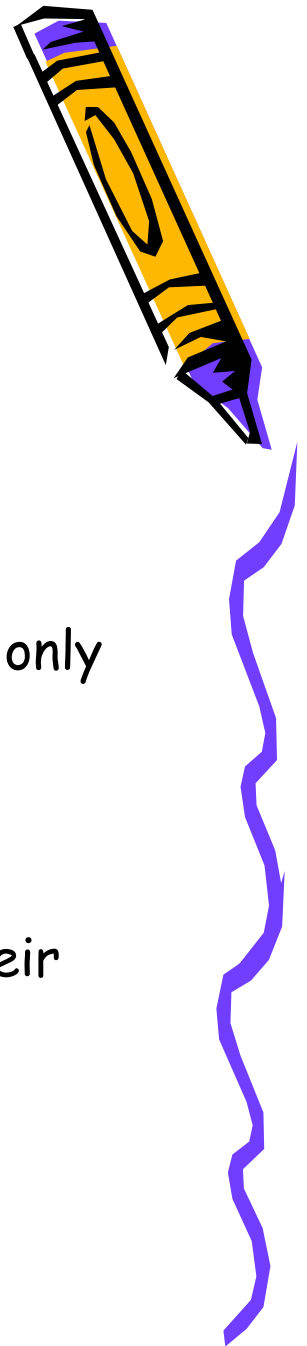

Enrollment Process

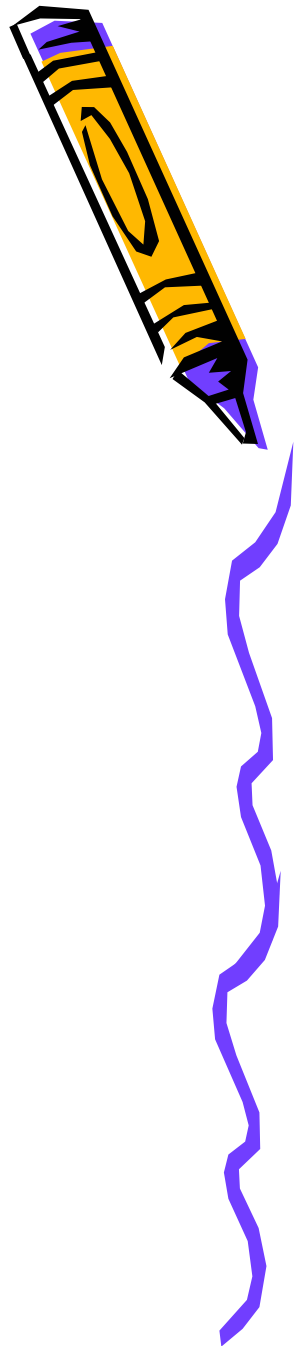


- Turn in Kdg. Pre-Registration Form

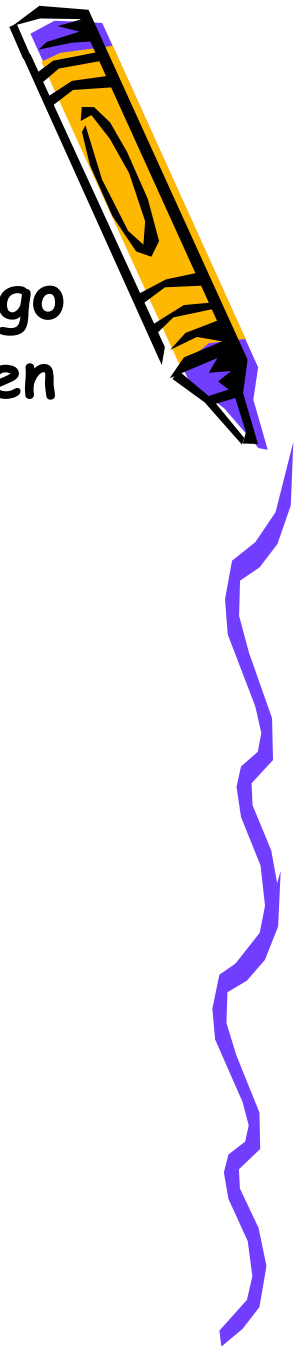
