

This spring, applications will be taken for membership in the National Junior Honor Society chapter here at JMS. The following criteria will be used by the selection committee to determine membership:

**5 POINTS**

**Character**

- No ISS/OSS
- No "N's" or "U's" in citizenship
- No more than 3 unexcused tardies per semester
- No late applications accepted

5 pts – All O's all quarters (18 O's)

4 pts – 15 – 17 O's

3 pts – 12 – 14 O's

2 pts – 9 – 11 O's

1 pts – 0 - 7 O's

**5 POINTS**

**Service**

- Only for the year of application
- Volunteerism and service to the community is highly valued
- Examples include membership in clubs, athletic teams, musical groups, student government, 4H, Science Olympiad, church groups, Boy or Girl Scouts, community activities

**Leadership**

- Only for the year of application
- Based on student's participation in two or more activities or election or appointment to positions in school or community activities
- While in those elected or appointed positions, student must have been directly responsible for directing or motivating others
- Examples include elected student government representative, club officer, committee chairperson, team captain, music section leader, newspaper editor, community leader

5 pts – 4 activities & 1 leadership role OR 6 activities

4 pts – 3 activities & 1 leadership OR 5 activities

3 pts – 2 activities & 1 leadership OR 4 activities

2 pts – 1 activity & 1 leadership OR 3 activities

1 pt – involvement in 2 activities

(Leadership or Volunteerism count as 2 activities for determination of points, with a maximum of 5 points).

**5 POINTS**

**Academics**

- No grade below a B- (No Cs)
- minimum GPA is 3.0

5 pts – 4.0 or greater

4 pts – 3.75 to 3.99

3 pts – 3.5 to 3.74

2 pts – 3.25 to 3.49

1 pt – 3.0 to 3.24

**QUALIFICATION FOR MEMBERSHIP**

Minimum 11 points out of 15
