This year I will help you develop your artistic skills and learn more about other people's art. We will learn about different cultures, specific styles of art and a few famous artists. We will also discuss the Elements of Art and Principles of Design. All of the rules and procedures we use in the classroom will help you enjoy the class and make you a more responsible person.

You should bring a pencil to class each day. I will supply other materials necessary to complete the project. Respect other people and your classroom supplies. Stay focused on your work and use your class-time as well as you can. Sitting in your assigned seat will help you stay focused. Always clean-up before the end of the class-time. If necessary, stay after class to clean-up instead of leaving a mess for the next class. All other rules in the student handbook apply as well. Students that are able to follow the rules will receive good grades, create great artwork, learn more, make better friends and have more fun.

If students break the rules, the consequences will be:

The first time – The student receives a verbal warning and I will make a note in my grade-book about the incident.

The second time – The student's seat will be changed.

The third time – The student's parents will be contacted.

Four or more – The student will receive a referral to the office.

Severe misbehavior, such as harassment, fighting, destruction of property, or defiant behavior, results in an immediate referral to the office (as stated in the student handbook).

Each student will receive three paper passes per marking period. Students may use these to take a quick trip to the bathroom, drinking fountain or their locker. If students need to leave more frequently, they (or their parents) should contact the school counselors and we will make accommodations. Students must bring their passes with them to class in order to be excused to leave.
