Semester 1



- **CSC (1100) + LAB: Computer Science: Problem Solving and Programming (4 credits)**
- Problem solving algorithms, and their realization as computer programs using a structured, general purpose programming language; data types, operators, expressions, assignment, input and output.
- **Lakeview Prerequisite: completion of Computer Applications I and II**
- **COM (1010): Oral Communication: Basic Speech (3 credits)**
- Beginning of course emphasizing fundamentals of speech preparation. Development of poise and confidence in speaking including persuasive speaking and additional presentations.
- **Lakeview Prerequisite: completion of Eng I, II, and III**
- **HIS (1000): World Civilization to 1500 (3 credits)**
- Survey of ancient and medieval history from the Neolithic Revolution to 1500
- **Lakeview Prerequisite: completion of World History, US History, and Econ/Government**



Semester 2

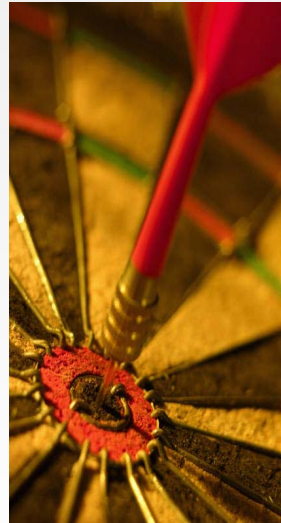


- **ENG (1020): Introductory College Writing (4 credits)**
- A course in writing and critical reading, including at least one appropriately documented paper based upon outside sources
- ***Lakeview Prerequisite: completion of Eng. I, II, III, IV***
- **PSY (1010): Introductory Psychology (4 credits)**
- Introduction to the science of behavior. Principles, concepts, and theories of human thought and action. Selected concepts illustrated through laboratory experiments.
- ***Other: students are advised to take Lakeview's Psychology/Sociology course first***
- **PHI (1010): Introduction to Philosophical Systems (3 credits)**
- Introduction to philosophy and the main schools of philosophical thought, through examination of some of the great philosophers of the past. Selected texts of writers such as Plato, Augustine, Aquinas, Descartes, Hume, Kant, Nietzsche, James, and Russell will be discussed

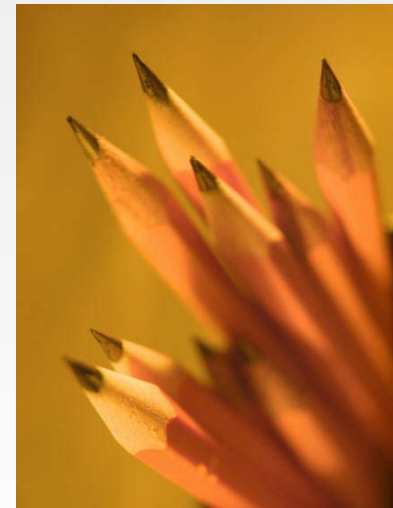
